

# EFFINGHAM COUNTY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE COVID-19 EVENT PROTOCOLS

**The health, safety, and comfort level of our guests is of utmost importance to the Effingham County Chamber of Commerce as we safely return to in-person meetings.**

**The Chamber has worked with our event venues to ensure they are operating with added cleaning and hygiene procedures to minimize contact risk.**

**We ask that all who attend our events follow the guidelines provided here:**

- Face coverings will be requested when entering the facility and event. A limited number of disposable masks will be available to attendees who need one. If you have a mask, please bring it. Masks may be removed when you reach your seat, but please put back on if you move about the room.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the registration desk.
- Physical distancing - We will limit the number of attendees to allow reasonable distance between yourself and others.
- As much as possible, Chamber staff will limit contact with individuals attending our functions. When contact is necessary, Chamber volunteers and staff will wear masks and other PPE.
- If you do not feel well (fever, chills, difficulty breathing), the Chamber requests that you do not attend.
- To the extent possible, the Chamber requests that attendees refrain from shaking hands, exchanging business cards, or otherwise making physical contact with one another.
