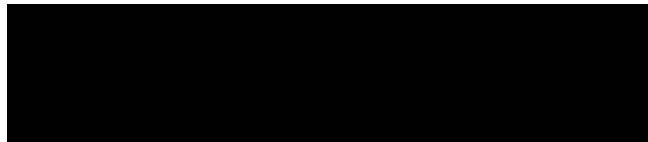

(6) \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded to children of current Prairie Farms Dairy patrons,

(6) \$2,000 similar scholarships will be awarded to sons and daughters of current Prairie Farms Dairy employees. Students may major in any field of study. A minimum of 3 years as a patron or employee is required. To be eligible, the parent must have been an employee or patron on or before February 6, 2008. Note: Illinois Farm Bureau membership is not required. *This scholarship requires a separate Prairie Farms Dairy application form.* Applications not available until December 1 and must be postmarked by February 1.
